CIK9 Training Program – June 9th & 10th, 2023 Training Opportunity



K9 Operational Medicine

WHEN: JUNE 9 & 10, 2023

TIME: 10am to 5pm EACH DAY, Lunch will be provided

INSTRUCTORS: Dustoff K9, Brady Smith/Director-Lead Instructor, Retired Army Special Forces Medic/K9 Handler with 14 yrs experience

This will be a 2-day seminar focusing on operational and field veterinary medicine, empowering handlers to stabilize their K9 at the point of injury and ready them for rapid transport and effective handoff to formal veterinary care. Course topics to include: K9 point of injury medicine (includes different types of trauma, airway, chest wounds, burns, hypothermia), opioid exposure, eat injuries, gastric dilatation volvulus. This seminar will include classroom instruction as well as hands-on practicums using K9 manikins with basic scenarios on the first day and the more difficult scenarios on day 2.
