Bridging the gap between handlers and prehospital care

WHEN: SEPTEMBER 27 & 28, 2024

This will be a 2-day seminar where the Handler will get classroom/table top demonstrations as well as the opportunity to practice with realistic hands-on K9 medical simulation mannequins in emergency, casualty scenarios, gaining critical knowledge for critical moments. Topics to include basic K9 anatomy & vital signs, point of injure care, bandaging, emergency planning & management, evacuation, narcotic toxicity, heat injury, and gastric dialation & volvulus (bloat). Evan Nolte/Owner-Instructor is a former US Paratrooper and Animal Care Sergeant. The majority of his 14-year career was spent working independently of a veterinarian, providing direct medial support to Special Operation dog teams at home and abroad.
