Topics to include basic K9 anatomy & vital signs, point of injure care, bandaging, emergency planning & management, evacuation, narcotic toxicity, heat injury, and gastric dialation & volvulus (bloat). The majority of his 14-year career was spent working independently of a veterinarian, providing direct medial support to Special Operation dog teams at home and abroad.
